

# The Smoking Ban

On 26th March 2006, a ban on smoking in enclosed public places and premises including the workplace, works vehicles and sports grounds and facilities came into force.

The law has been introduced to save lives and prevent illness caused by second hand smoke.

The new law brings with it responsibilities for all businesses throughout Scotland to ensure that their premises and works vehicles are smoke free and display the required signs.
